



### **Alice Krebs lodge**

The lodge is situated on the eastern slope of Beacon Hill in the View Rd South / Te Raekaihau headland Park. It overlooks Lyall Bay and Pencarrow Head and by walking about 5 meters to the top of hill, you can enjoy a panoramic view of both the south coast of the North Island and , across Cook Strait to the north coast of the South Island and Kaikoura mountains. From the lodge, bush tracks fan out across the park in several directions. Kae Miller provided the inspiration for the lodge, which was built in 1984 (with the help of the Volco Trust, Box Trust & Bruce Stewart from Tapu Te Ranga Marae).

**Description of the lodge:** It is a self-contained one bedroom with shower, toilet, kitchen and a lounge with a wood fire.

**How to get there:** The track to the lodge begins at the end of View Rd south. The No 23 bus stops about 100 meters from the track.
